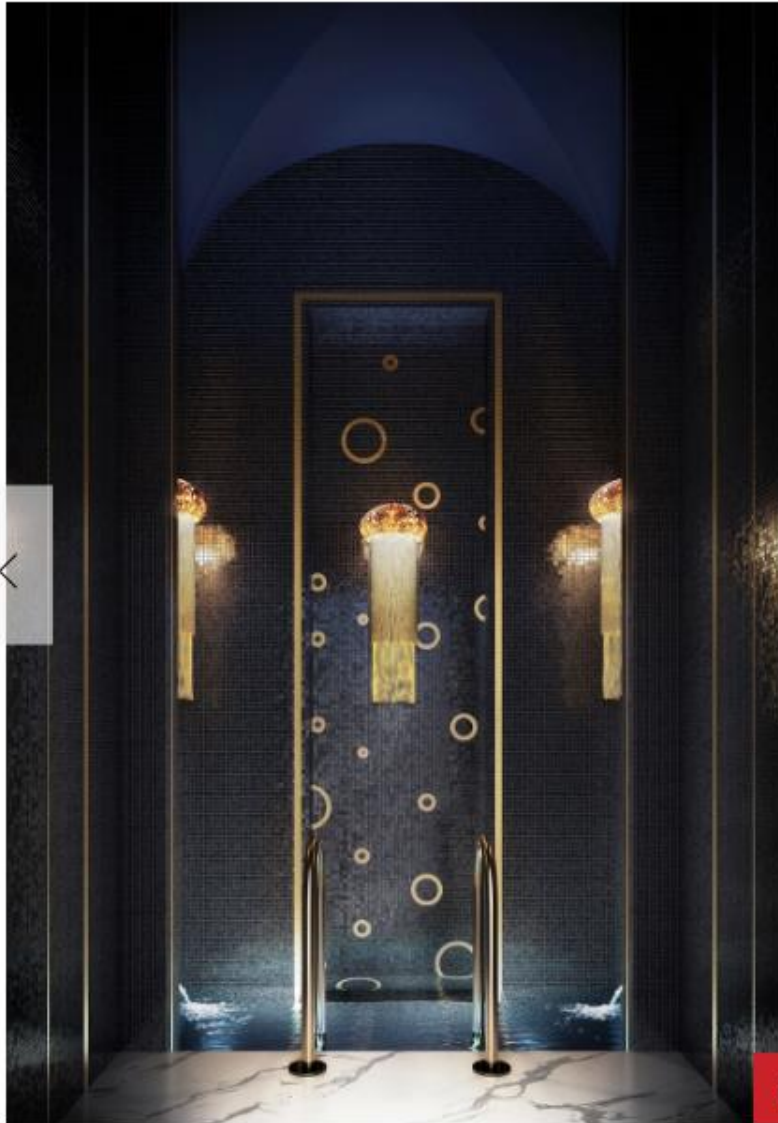


THE 7 MOST OVER-THE-TOP AMENITIES IN NYC

D'ORSAY ART DECO SPA

For starters, this luxury boutique condominium on 14th Street is the first apartment development by French architect and interior designer [Jacques Garcia](#).

He styled the [d'Orsay](#) building to resemble a five-star hotel, and, if we lived there, we probably wouldn't ever leave the private spa. It boasts an incredible Art Deco plunge pool, steam room, treatment rooms, and a lounge.

LEVEL'S VIRTUAL FITNESS CLASSES

We personally couldn't live at apartment development [Level](#) in Williamsburg, Brooklyn because the 3,300-square-foot, 24-hour fitness center has so many fitness class options, we'd have zero excuse to not work out.

It features Technogym cardio and weights, a yoga room with stretching equipment, and over 200 virtual fitness classes from [Wellbeats](#), including kickboxing, Pilates, Zumba, and cycling. Residents can create an account to personalize a workout plan based on their goals. More lethargic people can head to the deck to drift about the pool, whirlpool, or steam room.

50 WEST'S EXPERIENTIAL SHOWER

Good shower pressure is crucial for any apartment — but 50 West blows your average shower out of the, well, water.

The experiential shower in at [50 West's Water Club level](#), which features a pool, sauna and steam room, has six different "experience settings." You can try out a "tropical rainstorm," where it mists, showers, and steams as temperatures and lights change colors to sound effects of a rain forest. It's meant to transport you on an escape from the city, which is always necessary.

520 W. 28TH'S PRIVATE IMAX THEATER

It's one thing to live in an apartment building with the city's first private IMAX theater. It's another thing entirely when that apartment and IMAX theater were custom designed by the late and legendary Zaha Hadid.

Hadid designed the entire building at [520 w. 28th](#) in West Chelsea as a gorgeous harmony of curved lines and glass that overlooks the High Line. With its rubbed metal exterior, the sculptural building is one of the city's real estate jewels.
