This new development, at the point where the West Village, the Meatpacking District and Chelsea meet, is the first foray into the New York residential market by French designer Jacques Garcia. Entitled d'Orsay, the project was approached as a boutique hotel and incorporates French influences.

Garcia will work on d'Orsay's interiors, while Hill West Architects are appointed to design the overall architecture of the European-inspired building. The structure, which was developed by Adellco Corporation, spans 11 storeys and consists of 21 residences.

The residences will range from one to four bedroom apartments, a penthouse and a separate townhouse. Most units have private outdoor space, while all of them can take full advantage of the wide variety of high-end amenities available.
